1. The Semester wise Lesson plan of all the faculty members will get prepared and displayed on college website.



- A Representation will be made to the Affiliating University for establishing "On the spot examination evaluation centre" and "Empanelment of Teachers for the Paper setting".
- 3. The Proposal for New Programme(s) will be sent to Directorate for due consideration.
- 4. To facilitate the E- learning, use of ICT tools will be encouraged. Faculty members will be made compulsory to take at least one class in a month using ICT tools from the coming academic session.
- 5. All the Departments who are available with Smart class room will ensure Proper record of ICT Classes taken there.
- A student satisfaction survey will be conducted for the outgoing UG/PG students.
- 7. To promote the sense of Entrepreneurship among the students, Entrepreneurship development club will organize Workshops on Entrepreneurship and related issues.
- 8. NSS/NCC/Red cross society of the institute will organize activities related to social issues in collaboration of NGO's only.
- 9. The possibility of MOU's for faculty exchange with other universities will be explored.
- 10. To enhance capacity building among teachers, scholars and students, a proposal to organize 'Multidisciplinary National seminar' in next academic session will be sent to the Directorate for approval and sponsorship.
- 11. To promote research among students, a 5/7- Day workshop on Research Methodology for PG final year students will be organized.
- 12. Awareness seminars regarding Availability of facilities (rare books, e-journals & manuscripts etc) in library facilities will be organized.
- 13. Mechanism of Internal Compliance committee will get framed and displayed on college website.



- 14. The Administrative and Professional development trainings will be organized for the teaching and non teaching staff.
- 15. To curb negative environment impact and lower electricity bill, the process for installation of Solar system will be initiated.
- 16. To Promote sense of eco-friendliness in the campus, the institute will observe 'Smoky Vehicle free campus day' on every last working day of the month. Only Emission free vehicles (electric vehicles, bicycle etc.) will be allowed to enter.
- 17. Code of Conduct for teachers/students will be framed and displayed on institution website.
- 18. All the washrooms at ground floor in the institute will be maintained as per the guidelines received from UGC for divyangjan.
- 19. Under the Best Practices of Institute:
 - a. Through 'Go Green Drive'
 - (i) The Guest(s) are honored with Plants instead of memento & other materialistic recognitions.
 - (ii) Tree plantation by the Guest(s) in the institution will be initiated.
 - b. The Institute will arrange a consolidated fund from the teachers which will be used to recognize the students who will perform exceptionally in academics and non academic sectors.
