Clarification in respect of admissions in Post Graduate P.G) courses are as under:-

- 1) All P.G admissions shall be made through Online Admission Portal only.
- 2) There shall be no registration charges for online submission of admission form on account of COVID-19 pandemic situation.
- 3) The State Reservation Policy & other general instructions shall be implemented on the same pattern of U.G admissions.
- 4) The Common weightage criteria for the purpose of merit towards admission in P.G courses shall be applicable for all the affiliated colleges.

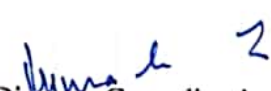
In case of tie, the candidate upper in age shall be placed upper in merit.

6) The Principals shall get upload eligibility conditions on college website for admissions towards P.G courses offered by their colleges. Applicants must ensure to check and cross-verify their eligibility towards a particular course on the affiliating university/college website before online submission of admission form.

7) During the process, of documents verification, the colleges must ensure to check & verify the eligibility of students accurately as per affiliating university norms. In case, an applicant is non-eligible or any other discrepancy exists, appropriate action shall be taken up by the colleges.
